Topic: Overview on Basic Life Support, Managing Cardiac arrest, & Fundamentals of using a Bag Valve Mask Resuscitator (Ambubag) & AED (Automated External Defibrillator).

Despite important advancements in prevention, sudden cardiac arrest remains the leading cause of death. Seventy percent occur at home and the rest are mostly in the workplace. The outcome from out-of-hospital arrest remains poor.

Basic Life Support consists of a number of medical procedures provided to patients with life threatening conditions of the body, that cause pain or dysfunction to the person. All these techniques are focused on helping patients or sustain life until more precise medical treatment can begin. To some, it can make the difference between life and death! It is thus important that dentists are equally equipped with the necessary knowledge and awareness about BLS and CPR to ensure that they can deliver necessary life-saving measures in cases of emergency. This lecture focuses on the principles and techniques of basic life support and CPR with emphasis given to managing cardiac arrest which is the most common medical emergency seen in a dental clinic setting.

The fundamentals of using, managing and after-care of a Bag Valve Mask (AMBU: Artificial Manual Breathing Unit) bag and AED simulation will also be taught. This is rather important as the AMBU bag is now a compulsory device for every dental clinic to have as it is the simplest and easiest form life saving modality any healthcare professional can provide.

You will learn the psychomotor skills and will practice delivery of High-quality Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation in adults, infant and child. The knowledge and skills learnt in the course would provide you the competency and the confidence and thus giving victims the best chance of survival. This lecture is a useful practical introduction to the BLS Course.
